

CLASSROOM RULES

1. Follow instructions.
2. Be on time and prepared. Be ready to learn.
3. No teasing, harassing, bullying, put downs or using inappropriate language.
4. Keep hands, feet, and all objects to yourself.
5. No electronics, food, drink or gum.

Consequences for Minor Behavior Problems

1st : Warning

2nd : 5-minute Time-out

3rd : 10-minute Time Out

4th : Parent Contact

5th : Referral to Administration

**Severe or Repetitive behavior problems will be directly referred to Administration*

ROUTINES AND PROCEDURES

Entering the Classroom

- Go to assigned seat
- Bring out materials to start warm-up activity
- Backpacks on the floor
- Low noise level

Leaving the Classroom/ Dismissal

- Clean your area
- Return materials used
- Wait on your seat for teacher's signal or when bell rings to dismiss you.
- Push chairs in

Direct Instruction/ Lecture

- Stay on assigned seat
- Bring out materials
- Raise hand for questions during whole-class interaction and wait to be called on
- Quiet noise level

Small Group Activity

- Stay in your area
- Approved materials
- Moderate noise level

Independent Work

- Stay in your seat
- Approved materials
- Zero noise level

Pencil Sharpening/ Getting Materials

- If the teacher is teaching, do NOT go
- If someone is already there, do NOT go
- If 1 and 2 are clear, GO

On Time-Out

- Go to assigned seat
- No materials (Behavior Contract)
- No talking

Being Tardy

- Do not talk to the teacher or classmates
- Sign the tardy book
- Sit in your assigned seat
- Get engaged in the lesson
- See teacher before dismissal

Sign-Out

- Get permission from the teacher using hand signal.
- Sign out, sign in
- Get engaged in the lesson.

Turning In Paper

- Stay in your seat
- Pass paper to person in front
- Quiet noise level

Receiving Paper/Material

- Stay in your seat
- Pass paper/material to person behind you
- Quiet noise level
